The large artwork below, 'Gnow Boodja', was done by our very talented local artists Isobel Hodgson and Melita Hayward.



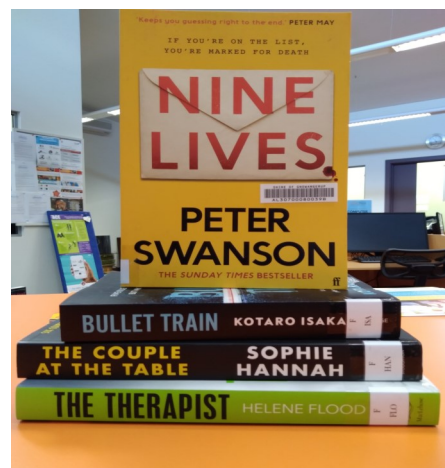
FROM THE DEPOT

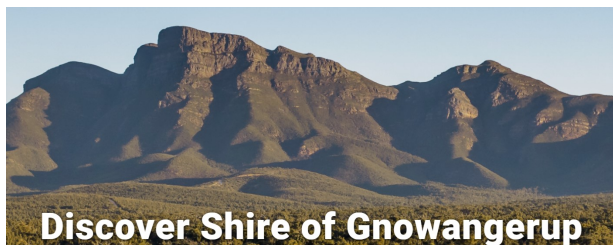

1080 Poison Training

with Peter Hennig, DPIRD Biosecurity Officer



Foxes are estimated to cost Australian sheep farmers \$35 million dollars annually. They also have a devastating impact on native wildlife. If you are planning to conduct a 1080 baiting program you must hold a permit to use restricted chemical product in Western Australia.

This free face-to-face session is delivered by DPIRD Biosecurity Officer Peter Hennig and meets the training requirements to apply for Registered Pesticide (RP) permits. Peter will also help you map the proposed bait areas and exclusion zones for your property. Catering sponsored by Elders.
