Due to above average rainfall, there is a large mosquito population in the Shire this year. Please be aware that baiting and the use of larvicide has commenced and will continue throughout the summer - our Works Depot is doing a fantastic job keeping on top of this issue. WHAT YOU CAN DO

'There is currently no cure and no vaccine for any mosquito-borne disease acquired in WA.

The only way to prevent infection is to avoid being bitten by mosquitoes.

Cover Up – wear long, loose-fitting, light coloured clothing, covering as much of the body as you can.

Repel – When outdoors and mosquitoes are present, apply insect repellent containing DEET (diethyltoluamide) or picaridin evenly to exposed skin.

Clean Up – simple changes around your home can reduce mosquito breeding. Remove, empty or cover water-holding containers.'

The ongoing restoration of the Gnowangerup Star is continuing, and this week three volunteers; Iva Stejskal, Lex Martin and Keith Schekkerman spent three days restoring machinery, equipment and printing materials. Keith is a printer by trade and was able to get two of the printing presses operational; the manual Plano Press and the electric Heidelberg Press. This is a great milestone in returning the print shop to operating status. Lead type and printing blocks have been cleaned and stored and repairs to the building are continuing. This was a continuation of works being carried out over the last two years by the Shire and volunteers. Further updates on this ongoing work will be provided in future months. Shire president Fiona Gaze attended and saw the presses working first hand.
