BACKGROUND

Four companies were invited to quote through the WALGA e-Quote system on the 2021/22 bitumen-sealing program.

COMMENT

The following three companies provided quotes:

- Fulton Hogan
- Downer
- Bitutek Pty Ltd

Note: Colas Western Australia Pty Limited declined to quote.

Both Fulton Hogan and Bitutek met the required specifications. Downer gave a fixed price instead of an individual breakdown as requested however, the quote was still accepted.

After the assessment, the quotes are ranked in the following order:

1. Fulton Hogan
2. Bitutek
3. Downer

The assessments are rated in accordance with the overall cost figures.

Due to the estimated cost of the Contract exceeding \$250,000, it is a purchasing requirement to go to Tender, pursuant to Reg. 11(1) of the Local Government (Functions General) Regulations 1996.
