NETBALL CALVIN SIMS

Hundreds of players took part in the 29th edition of the Great Southern's High School Netball Cup at the Albany Leisure and Aquatic Centre this month.

Netball WA — Great Southern hosted the annual event on May 5 as 10 schools from across the region hit the courts.

More than 100 games were

played on the indoor and outdoor courts in glorious weather despite several squads being affected by COVID-19 in the region, reducing total team numbers from 46 to 42.

In the Year 7-8 girls' competition, Denmark finished 24-6 winners against Great Southern Grammar.

North Albany Senior High School finished winners over Denmark, recording a 12-7 tri-

umph in the Year 7-8 boys' division final.

Albany Senior High School had a 17-14 win over Narrogin Senior High School in the Year 9-10 girls' division final.

Bethel won the Year 9-10 boys' title with a 12-4 victory over NASHS in the decider.

In a high-scoring affair in the Year 11-12 girls' final, ASHS beat GSG convincingly, 24-15.

ASHS continued their su-

premacy in the Year 11-12 boys' division, defeating GSG by eight goals, 20-12. Netball WA — Great Southern regional team leader Kelly Dominiak said the organisation would look to provide more competitions with the provision of boys' and men's divisions at the Great Southern Regional Championships in July and eventually through the Great Southern associations.

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

For Council to consider the tender received for Tender RFT2022-3 Gardening Services Contract which closed 4.00pm, Monday 6 June 2022.

BACKGROUND

Tender RFT2022-3 Gardening Services Contract went out to state-wide Tender in the West Australian on 14 May 2022 and was also advertised on the Shire's website, Facebook page, local public notice boards, in the Borden, Gnowangerup and Ongerup newsletters as well as the Ongerup Library and Gnowangerup Library.

COMMENTS

The Shire of Gnowangerup currently outsources its gardening services rather than provide the services with Shire staff. The two main reasons for doing so are: attraction and retention of suitably skilled and qualified staff and the cost of purchasing and maintenance of specialised equipment that would be required.

It is noted that although the Tender is required to be advertised state-wide for legislative purposes, the significant local advertising coverage for this Tender shows that the engagement of service providers within the Shire of Gnowangerup is greatly encouraged.

The current contract with our Gardening Service Provider expires on 30 June 2022 so a decision is required to ensure continuity of service and standards.
At the time of closing, only one tender had been received.
