BUILDING ASSETS

Hot Water System replaced at 25 Mc Donald St residence.

DEPOT FUEL TANK ENVIRONMENTAL INVESTIGATIONS.

Report submitted to Department of Water and Environmental Regulation for consideration and determination.

Advice received that a decision would be delayed due to work load and low risk.

AVIATION

Aerodrome inspections of the Katanning Aerodrome were conducted on a works cost basis, through out August.

Civil Aviation Safety Authority have approved the test flying of a Remote Piloted Aircraft at the Gnowangerup Aerodrome by Innovaero.

Whilst promotional videos gave the impression that the unit was being developed for military purposes, Innovaero have advised that the intent is to develop a RPA with a suitable cargo carrying capacity for commercial operations including survey instruments.

STOLEN ASSET

Between 1330 on Friday 12 August 2022 and 1230 on Sunday 14 August 2022 the trailer and 100mm pump unit was stolen from the Airport Dam. Waste site CCTV and a Police Drone investigation didn't reveal any information. However on Tuesday 6 September the Shire was advised that part of the unit (Roof, Cage & Controller) had been seen in the bush behind the new dam. This was retrieved, it appears that this was removed from the trailer and neatly placed in the bush with no damage other than a cut cable. The police were advised.
