## PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

#### **INFRASTRUCTURE ACTIVITIES**

The Construction crew completed the gravel sheeting of Magitup Road. This was made difficult with the Iveco truck still down however, we were able to source a water truck which enabled us to continue.

The issue with the lveco truck is ongoing and we are now waiting for parts to arrive to see if this will fix the electrical issue. The truck is 10 years old and due for replacement next financial year.

The resealing of Boxwood Hill Ongerup Road and Bremer Bay Road is scheduled for late February or early March. This will see the funded jobs nearly complete and we will begin on the council funded projects.

Designs for the RAV widening on Quinn Street have been sent to Main Roads and Western Power and we are waiting to receive a response from them. There is a power pole that needs to be moved so this is an unknow cost and time frame however.
