WORKS

Repair works were carried out on Jackitup Road, Jackitup Road North, Foster Road, Parker Road and Toompup South Road as a result of a sudden heavy rain event on 17 June 2022.

A total of 151 hours of maintenance grading was carried out with the following roads being graded.

Bridgeman Road, Foster Road, Pandalup Road, Toompup South Road, Peerup Road, Bungey Road, Jackitup Road, Jackitup West Road, Jackitup North Road, Dooleys Road, Moores Dam Road, Dawson Road and Kelly Road.

In addition to the grader mounted rollers, additional multi tyre rollers are being used behind two of the graders.

Trees were removed from various roads as a result of the high winds.

Sand was stockpiled at the depot ready for use at the cemetery and other projects.

The additional, as required by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation, ground water sampling bores were established to check for the possible spread of the Depot Fuel Tanks plume. Initial results show no further spread of the plume. Lyon Environmental will now submit a report to the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation requesting no further monitoring be required and requesting a favourable reclassification of the site. It is likely that a condition will be imposed on the site of "No ground water to be taken".
