DECLARATION OF INTERESTS (NOTES FOR YOUR GUIDANCE)

A Member, who has a Financial Interest in any matter to be discussed at a Council or Committee Meeting that will be attended by the Member, must disclose the nature of the interest:

- a) In a written notice given to the Chief Executive Officer before the Meeting or;
- b) At the Meeting, immediately before the matter is discussed.

A member, who makes a disclosure in respect to an interest, must not:

- a) Preside at the part of the Meeting, relating to the matter or;
- b) Participate in, or be present during any discussion or decision-making procedure relative to the matter, unless to the extent that the disclosing member is allowed to do so under Section 5.68 or Section 5.69 of the Local Government Act 1995.

NOTES ON FINANCIAL INTEREST (NOTES FOR YOUR GUIDANCE)

The following notes are a basic guide for Councillors when they are considering whether they have a **Financial Interest** in a matter. These notes will be included in each agenda for the time being so that Councillors may refresh their memory.

1. A Financial Interest requiring disclosure occurs when a Council decision might advantageously or detrimentally affect the Councillor or a person closely associated with the Councillor and is capable of being measured in money terms. There are exceptions in the Local Government Act 1995 but they should not be relied on without advice, unless the situation is very clear.
2. If a Councillor is a member of an Association (which is a Body Corporate) with not less than 10 members i.e. sporting, social, religious etc.), and the Councillor is not a holder of office of profit or a guarantor, and has not leased land to or from the club, i.e., if the Councillor is an ordinary member of the Association, the Councillor has a common and not a financial interest in any matter to that Association.
3. If an interest is shared in common with a significant number of electors or ratepayers, then the obligation to disclose that interest does not arise. Each case needs to be considered.
4. **If in doubt declare.**
5. As stated in (b) above, if written notice disclosing the interest has not been given to the Chief Executive Officer before the meeting, then it **MUST** be given when the matter arises in the Agenda, and immediately before the matter is discussed.
6. Ordinarily the disclosing Councillor must leave the meeting room before discussion commences. The only exceptions are:
 - 6.1 Where the Councillor discloses the extent of the interest, and Council carries a motion under s.5.68(1)(b)(ii) or the Local Government Act; or
 - 6.2 Where the Minister allows the Councillor to participate under s.5.69(3) of the Local Government Act, with or without conditions.

INTERESTS AFFECTING IMPARTIALITY

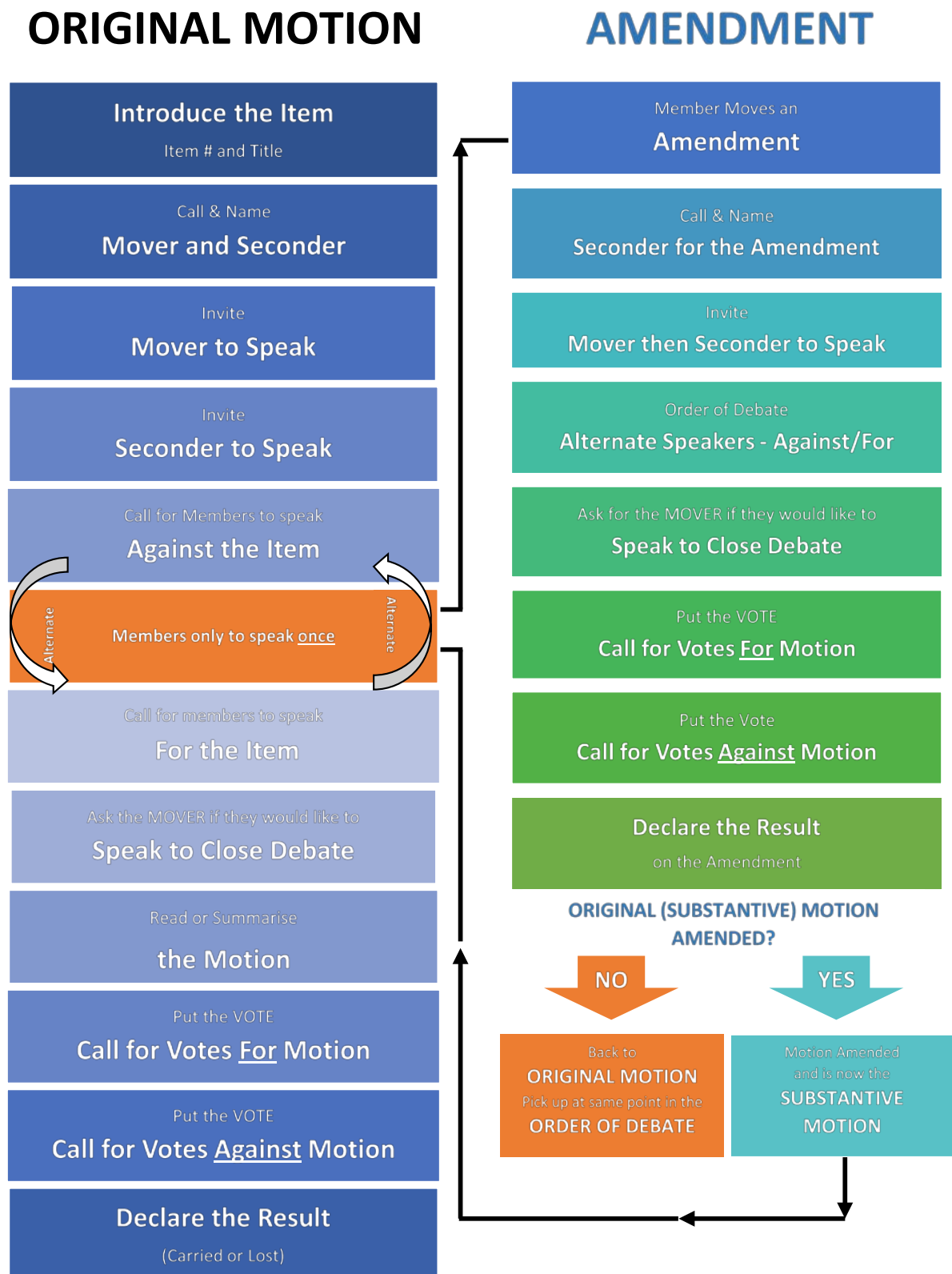
DEFINITION: An interest that would give rise to a reasonable belief that the impartiality of the person having the interest would be adversely affected, but does not include an interest as referred to in Section 5.60 of the 'Act'. A member who has an Interest Affecting Impartiality in any matter to be discussed at a Council or Committee Meeting, which will be attended by the member, must disclose the nature of the interest;

- (a) in a written notice given to the Chief Executive Officer before the Meeting; or
- (b) at the Meeting, immediately before the matter is discussed.

IMPACT OF AN IMPARTIALITY DISCLOSURE

There are very different outcomes resulting from disclosing an interest affecting impartiality compared to that of a financial interest. With the declaration of a financial interest, an elected member leaves the room and does not vote. With the declaration of this new type of interest, the elected member stays in the room, participates in the debate and votes. In effect then, following disclosure of an interest affecting impartiality, the member's involvement in the Meeting continues as if no interest existed.

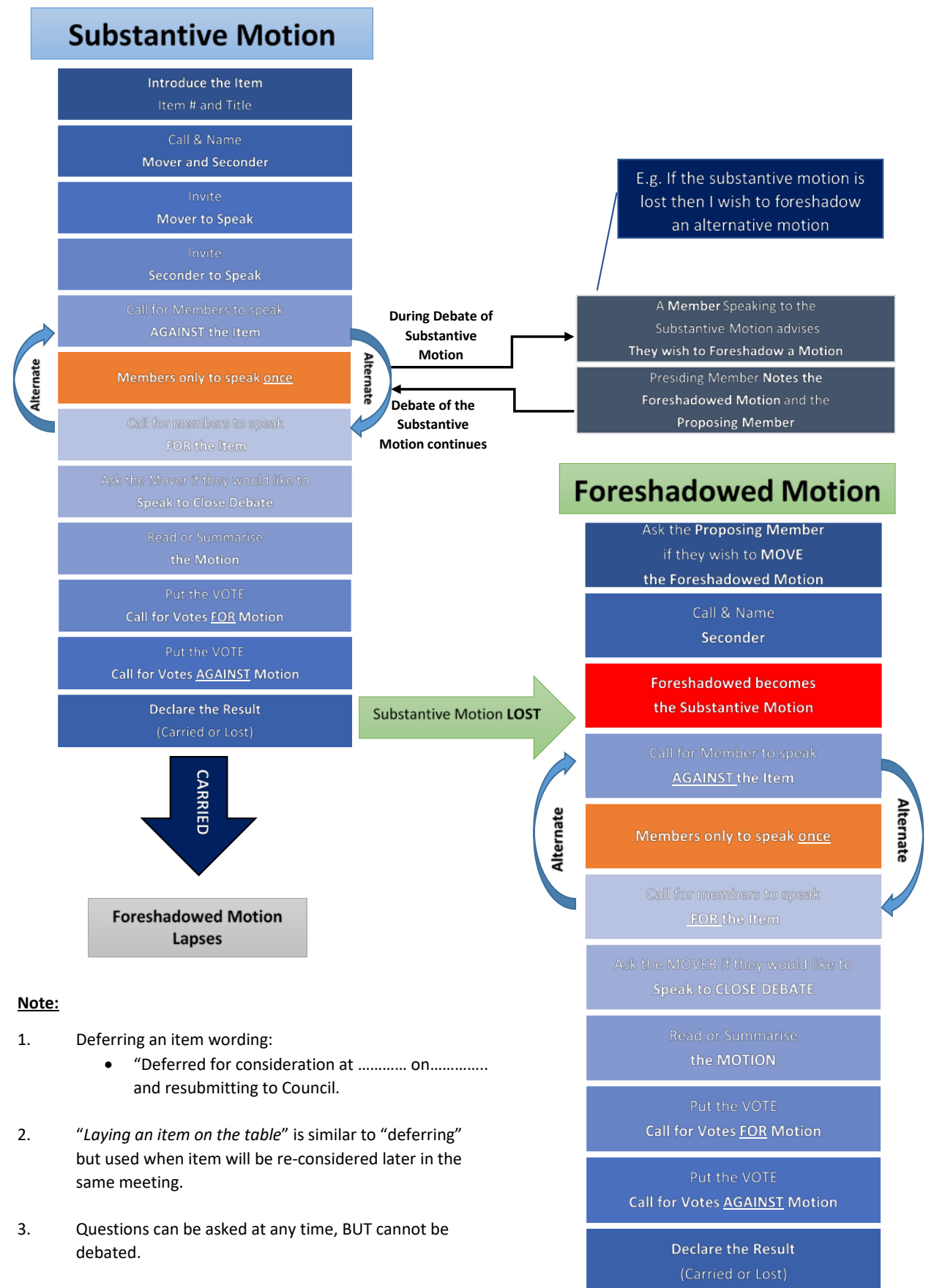

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

For Council to endorse the reallocation of funds to cover a contractor variation for the Regional Road Group (RRG) funded Kwobrup Road Project.

COMMENT

It has been determined by the Manager of Works that an undesirable subgrade material was milled into the basecourse during stabilisation and that a 500m stretch of the road does not meet an acceptable standard.

The Shire did not do any geotechnical investigation prior to the Tender being awarded and because of this, the Shire will need to cover some of the additional cost that is required to complete the job.

To repair the pavement, the Shire will need to import an additional 1,000m³ of gravel which will be spread and compacted to a depth of 100mm over the 500m length of road. There are also some areas of lime stabilisation that will be carried out on parts of the pavement that have a high clay content.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

If endorsed by Council, the impact on the budget will be nil as the Officer's Recommendation is that the required funds to cover the variation are reallocated from GL: 39112 Road Maintenance, Job Number RM200 Road Maintenance Sundry.

The Kwobrup Road Project is a 2/3 funded by Main Roads WA through the RRG Program. The Project was originally costed at a total of \$573,001 with funds of \$382,000 coming from RRG and the remaining \$191,001 being the Shire's 1/3 contribution.

A variation of \$8,445 (GST Exclusive) has been approved but due to the immateriality of the variation, Council endorsement was not required. In this instance, due to the significance of the variation, Council approval is being sought.

The original variation request came in at a cost of \$160,540.20 but with negotiations between the Manager of Works and MCC Contractors, the final value of this variation is \$82,434 (GST Exclusive) as per attached.

DESCRIPTION OF THE VARIATION:

Title: Culvert and Headwall removal and replace - Slk 7

The existing culvert is an old-style butt joined culvert that is in poor condition. Culverts are of this nature are no longer manufacture or available to extend the pipe by 1.4 metres. Headwalls are also not available to suit this class of pipe.



Removal of the existing culvert and replacement recommended with the use of 375 mm SN08 HDPE culverts and precast concrete headwalls.

DESCRIPTION OF THE VARIATION:

Areas between slk 7.12 and 8.14 have failed due to unsuitable in situ material that requires box out and replacement.

Unsuitable material – SLK 7.16 to SLK 7.85 LHS

- Box out - 4.8m wide x 690m long = 3312m² x 100mm deep = 331m³.
- Subgrade preparation and compaction
- Import 525m³ client supplied gravel for base course layer (130mm layer with bulking factor of 25% - spread to level)
- 3312m² of pavement stabilisation at 1%, compact and trimmed for sealing by others.

Slk 7.12 to slk 8.14 both sides

- Top up with 30mm client supplied gravel at shire works depot - 9.4m wide x 1020m = 9588m² - 3312m² (1) = 6276m² x 30mm deep = 244m³ (inclusive of 25% bulking factor)
- 6276m² of pavement stabilisation with 3% lime at a depth of 200mm.

Slk 8.32 to slk 8.27

- Top up with 30mm client supplied gravel at shire works depot - 4.8m wide x 50m long = 240m² (10m³ of Gravel).
- Lime stabilise to 3% at 250mm deep.

Slk 8.52 to slk 8.70

- Top up with 30mm client supplied gravel at shire works depot - 7.1m wide x 180m long = 1276m² (50m³ of Gravel).
- Lime stabilise to 3% at 250mm deep.

Slk 9.08 to slk 9.18

- Top up with 30mm client supplied gravel at shire works depot - 4.8m wide x 100m long = 480m² (19m³ of Gravel).
- Lime stabilise to 3% at 250mm deep.

Disposal of unsuitable materials to be at the Shires landfill for tip cover.
